

An eighty one year old man presented with a history of polio / post polio syndrome. Recently he lost function in his left leg. He had a flexion deformity and was unable to straighten the leg. Ambulation was not possible, he was wheel chair bound. The leg could be extended passively but there was great muscle resistance to straightening. Strength was rated 2/5 in the left, 5/5 in the right lower extremity. He had two courses of physical therapy w/o benefit. MRI revealed a tumor of the proximal femur. See yellow arrows.
